**Notice**

The Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO), in pursuance of implementation of e-Governance has rolled out online service for filing applications for the grant of registration of Cosmetics & Ethics Committee on the SUGAM portal ([www.cdscoonline.gov.in](http://www.cdscoonline.gov.in)) w.e.f. 06.06.2016 & 15.06.2016 respectively. In this regard, a notice dated 30.05.2016 has been published & uploaded on the CDSCO website.

Overall review of the online service for filling applications for grant of registration of Cosmetics & Ethics Committee have been carried out on 07.06.2016 where Senior Officers of CDSCO & CDAC participated, while Ms Malathi Narayan, representative of IBHA was online. It was observed that the system is not operative satisfactorily due to non-validation of the regulatory requirement by CDAC. Concern has also been raised by the Cosmetics industry Association with respect to the validation of the online application system. Sh. Rahul Gautam, CDAC official was appraised and asked for calling the Association of importers of Cosmetics & its members to develop flawless operational platform for registration of Cosmetics for import in the SUGAM online portal. Similar approach is to be adopted for registration of Ethics Committees. The stake holders/applicants would attempt for online submission of documents & if they fail, then hard copy of the applications may be accepted for a period of one month with an understanding that they had attempted the online application but couldn't get through.
